REGARDING ONE (1.00) MILL RENEWAL LEVY/SENIOR SERVICES
RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Belmont County Board of Commissioners anticipates levying a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation as described herein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code as amended by Am. Sub. S.B. No 201 enacted by the 122nd General Assembly, this Board of Commissioners is required to certify to the County Auditor a resolution requesting the County Auditor to certify certain matters in connection with such a tax levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary that a <u>renewal</u> tax be levied in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Belmont County to supplement the General Fund for the purpose of *providing and maintaining senior services and facilities including but not limited to, transportation, nutrition and in-home services to elderly residents at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (.10) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing with tax list year 2017 (Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(Y).*

SECTION 2. That the question of the passage of said tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of Belmont County at a General election to be held on the 8^{th} day of November, 2016. If approved by the electors, said tax levy shall first be placed upon the 2017 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2018.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to this Board of Commissioners the total current tax valuation of the Belmont County Senior Citizens Levy and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills specified in Section 1 hereof, and the Clerk of this Board of Commissioners be and is hereby directed to certify forthwith a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor so that said County Auditor may certify such matters in accordance with such Section 5705.03.

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Commissioners concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board of Commissioners, and that all deliberations of this Board of

Commissioners were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the rules of this Board of Commissioners adopted in accordance therewith.

OPEN PUBLIC FORUM-Barton resident John Henthorne voiced his concerns regarding the pot holes on Barton-Blaine Road. The cold patch that was put in last year didn't stay. He talked with Engineer Fred Bennett about the situation last week. He presented pictures to the Board of Commissioners. Mr. Bennett said an oil company will be paving a portion of the road. Mr. Thomas said he will send Mr. Bennett a message regarding the situation. Mr. Thomas said the roads are the Engineer's responsibility under code. Mrs. Favede encouraged Mr. Henthorne to have a conversation with Deputy Engineer Terry Lively since he will be County Engineer starting January 1, 2017. ANGELA HATFIELD, BELMONT COUNTY DOG SHELTER

9:30 Agenda Item: Angela Hatfield, Director, Belmont County Dog Shelter Re: Department Update

Angela Hatfield gave an update on the Belmont County Dog Shelter. Ms. Hatfield said the facility is the only shelter in Belmont County. The purpose of the shelter is to house and adopt stray or owner surrendered dogs and cats. From January to May, 2016, the shelter took in 374 animals and adopted out 423. In 2015, 1,132 animals were taken in and 1,108 were adopted out. "We do a phenomenal job of adoptions, working with rescues. Statistically, if you look back over the years, it's always neck-and-neck," said Ms. Hatfield. Ms. Hatfield noted the shelter's records are computerized. Information on the animal's status is available. She said they use a shelter management program that tracks everything such as adoptions, vaccines and finances. They are also working on obtaining a 501(3)C non-profit status that will allow fundraising efforts that would help with the needs of the shelter. She noted that groups from schools, churches, Boy Scouts and senior citizens have volunteered their help at the shelter. The Board of Commissioners thanked Ms. Hatfield and her staff for their efforts in helping the animals.
