- **All people listed on the deed must sign the easement and must attend.**
- **Spouses not on the deed must also attend.**
- **Bring a form of ID, preferably a driver's license.**
- **Residents must attend one of the two meetings.**

Project Description

The Village of Barnesville is moving forward with plans to extend public water service to the areas of Hendrysburg and Mt. Olivett Road in Belmont County and the Village of Fairview in Guernsey County.

- Creating a water loop along Mt. Olivett-Road to eliminate dead-end lines and improve water quality.
- Construction of a new booster station.
- Relocation of the existing water drop station at the I-70 and SR 800 Interchange.
- Provide public water to homes who rely on private water wells.

Construction is anticipated to begin in **mid-2026** and will last approximately **8 months**.

New Connection Information

Connection is voluntary. There is no mandatory connection.

If you connect during initial construction and provide an easement, the following costs will be covered by the project:

- Meter pit
- Water meter
- Service line from the street to your building's foundation

That means there is no cost to you for these items if you sign the easement and connect during construction. There are no income restrictions or applications for the homeowner.

The easement only applies to the area on your property needed for construction, not your entire property.

If you decline to provide an easement, you may still connect later, but you'll be responsible for the current tap fee of \$3,300 (subject to change) for the meter pit and water meter.

The service line from the street and connection to the dwelling or business is not included in the tap fee and will be a property owner expense.
