- 6. Provide photographs for all structures for the county files.
- Provide fracture critical inspections at arms length for 8 trusses and 2 girders on the County's inventory.

CLAUSE II - WORK SCHEDULE

The consultant agrees to begin immediately upon authorization to proceed. The work will be completed by the end of 2022.

CLAUSE III - PRIME COMPENSATION

The County agrees to compensate the Consultant for the performance of the work specified in the Agreement as follows:
