Discussion-Present: Belmont County Job and Family Services Director and Jack Regis, Jr., Fiscal Administrator.

Mr. Felton explained the .35 mill Children Services levy that was up for renewal this fall will be dropped. He said after reviewing with the Board of Commissioners it was decided not to renew. Mr. Felton also explained the SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits have been issued for October, he is not sure if they will be issued for November due to the government shutdown. He noted 14% of Belmont County residents receive the benefits. He is also unsure if the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds will be affected due to the shutdown. Mr. Felton said, "States have surpluses in TANF, but we don't know if TANF benefits are going to be issued to recipients or not. The vast majority of TANF recipients in Belmont County are caregivers. So grandparents who are taking care of their grandchild receive a cash benefit for doing that."

National Breast Cancer Awareness Month

WHEREAS, chances are, you know at least one person who has been personally affected by breast cancer; and
WHEREAS, in 2025, in the United States an estimated 316,950 women will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer, as well as 59,080 new cases of non-invasive breast cancer; and
WHEREAS, approximately 66% of breast cancer cases are diagnosed at a localized stage, before the cancer has spread outside of the breast, when it's easiest to treat; and
WHEREAS, the overall 5-year relative survival rate for cancer diagnosed at the localized stage is 99% and there are currently over 4 million breast cancer survivors in the United States; and
WHEREAS, breast cancer death rates have slowly decreased since 1989, for an overall decline of 43% through 2020. This is in part due to better screening and early detection efforts, increased awareness, and continually improving treatment options; and
WHEREAS, we recognize breast cancer survivors, those battling the disease, their families, friends, and co-workers who are a source of love, encouragement, and support, and applaud the efforts of medical professionals and researchers working to find a cure for this deadly disease; and
WHEREAS, National Breast Cancer Awareness Month is an opportunity to unite all citizens in Belmont County to raise awareness of the disease.
