#### IN THE MATTER OF DISCUSSION HELD

#### RE: DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES UPDATE

Dwayne Pielech, Director of Belmont County Department of Job & Family Services and Deputy Director Jack Cera discussed the 5 year plan for the Workforce Investment Act Board.

Mr. Pielech explained that the agency had taken parts of the 5 year plan from the former plan and made a few minor modifications suggested by the State that were necessary to meet the current requirements of the State. The new plan will contain new census numbers and also address some other issues such as the impact of the steel industry on our county. These revisions require the Board's approval before they can be submitted to the State.

Mr. Cera informed the Board that the plan identifies the Martins Ferry Office as the one-stop location. The agency feels this is an adequate location. Mr. Cera explained that basically, the revised plan is the same as what was approved last year, only difference is the Department of Job and Family Services is no longer part of the Five County Council of Government. Mr. Arnold Thompkins has agreed to come in and consult with the Agency to get the 5 Year Plan started since he was already under agreement under the Five County Council of Governments.

# Workforce Investment Board

Letters have been sent to area Chamber of Commerce's asking for recommendations for appointments to the WIA Board. A list has been created based on the recommendations received. The Central Council in each county should recommend a member to the Board. Nada Hanes brought a section of the Ohio Revised Code that is relevant to the Union's appointment to Dwayne's attention.
